



Overland to Kashgar from Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan via Turugart Pass

Overview

The China-Kyrgyzstan border post at Turugart is fairly straightforward. It's a two-day drive from Bishkek to Kashgar and vice-versa. For this option all transportation within Kyrgyzstan you must arrange on your own. We will pick you up at the Turugart pass and shuttle you to Kashgar. At the end of the expedition we drop you off back at the Turugart pass.

Detailed Itinerary TO Kashgar

Below is a suggested travel schedule from Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan

30 June Monday Depart Bishkek

Depart Bishkek for China. You will have to spend a night on the way to the Turugart Pass.

01 July Tuesday Arrive Kashgar

Arrive Turugart Pass before noon. Both countries' custom formalities are done here. We pick you up on the Chinese side of the Turugart Pass and shuttle you to Kashgar.

Detailed Itinerary FROM Kashgar

23 July Wednesday Base camp - Kashgar

Today we depart base camp and drive to Tashkurgan, arriving Kashgar either late afternoon or early evening.

24 July Thursday Enter Kyrgyzstan

This morning we shuttle you to the Turugart Pass where you both countries' customs formalities take place. From here you must arrange your own transportation back to Bishkek.
